Fire Service Testing of Elevators must follow A17.1-2013, section 8.6.4.19.6 and will be jointly performed by a Nevada State Fire Marshal licensed fire alarm contractor and an Elevator Service Company holding a valid C7 license. These tests must be witnessed by a Special Inspector/State Inspector.

Due to the current limited private sector resources available and for a limited time, until further notice by the division; A Special Inspector/State Inspector may accept a certificate of testing from a Nevada State Fire Marshal licensed fire alarm contractor and an Elevator Service Company holding a valid C7 license. The certificate must be signed by both as verification that testing has been successfully completed should the Special Inspector/Inspector not be available the day of the scheduled testing.
