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REPORT OF INSPECTION AND TEST


This Notice summarizes the actions to be taken by a Special Inspector when reporting annual testing.

The Special Inspector that witnesses the annual test of an elevator or escalator will note all of the tests results on a form prescribed by the Mechanical Compliance Section and forward a completed form to the Mechanical Compliance Section within ten (10) business days of the test.


NAC 455C.512(3) provides that, "A special inspector must witness any periodic tests on an elevator." Pursuant to A17.1, 2013 edition, Paragraph 8.6.1.7.2, the metal test tags with the applicable code requirement(s), date(s) performed, and the name of the person or firm performing the test, must be readily visible and securely attached to the Controller door. The results from the most recent test can be used to confirm compliance with testing requirements. The Special Inspector shall report to the Mechanical Compliance Section that the metal test tag is present and the date the tests were performed. If an object's operating permit has expired or is about to expire, an operating permit will be issued on this compliant test tag data. If the results set forth on the most recent test tag are not in compliance, a Notice of Violation will be written and the operating permit will not be issued.
