



**Chart 2. Incidence rates per 100 full-time workers for total nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses by industry division, Nevada and All United States, 2003**






**Chart 5A. Percent distribution of nonfatal occupational illnesses


**Chart 5B. Percent distribution of nonfatal occupational illnesses


**Chart 5C. Percent distribution of nonfatal occupational illnesses
