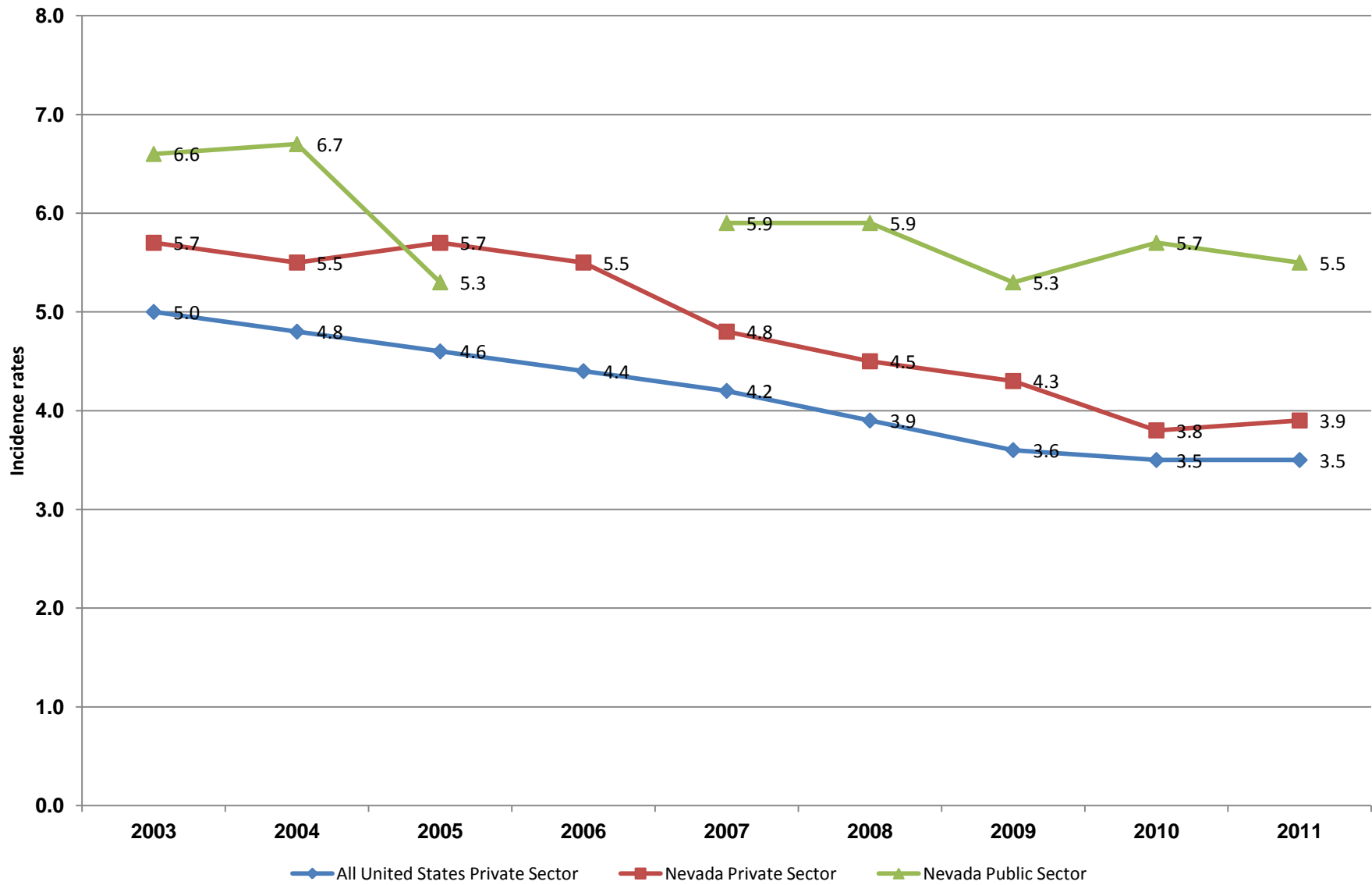


Chart 2. Incidence rates per 100 full-time workers for total nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses by major industry sector, Nevada and All United States, 2011

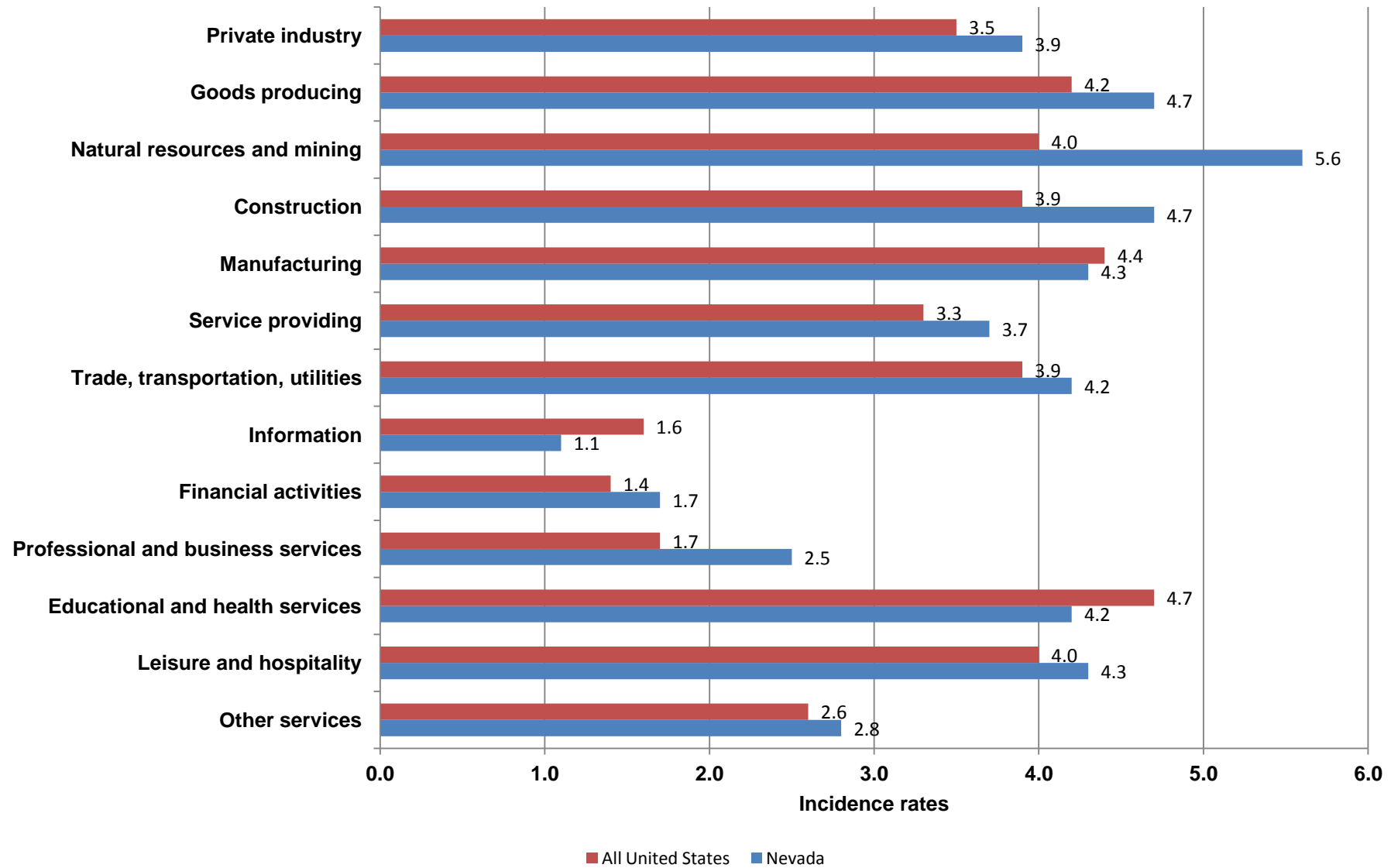


Chart 3. Incidence rates per 100 full-time workers for total nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses by major industry sector, Nevada, 2010 & 2011

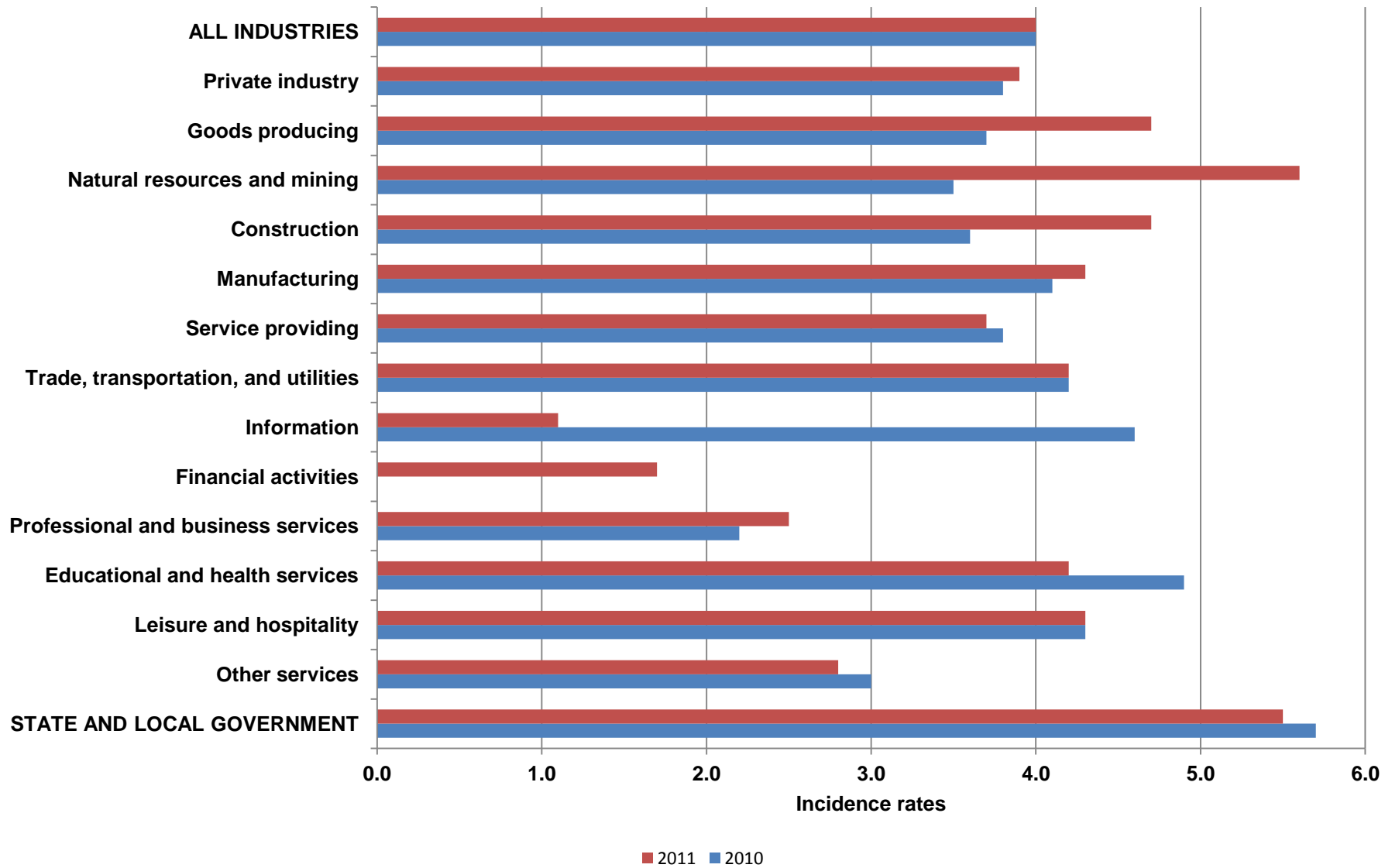
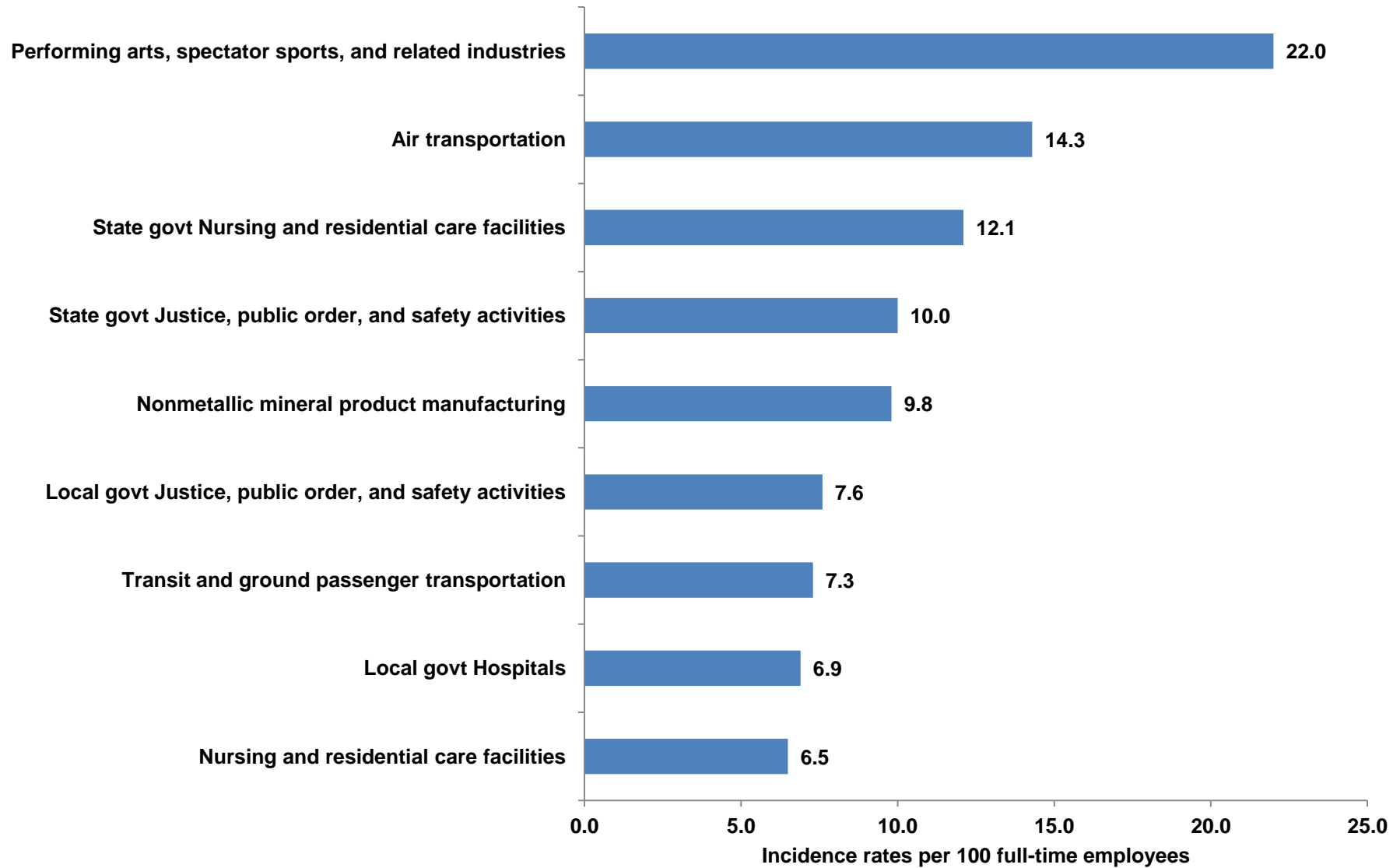
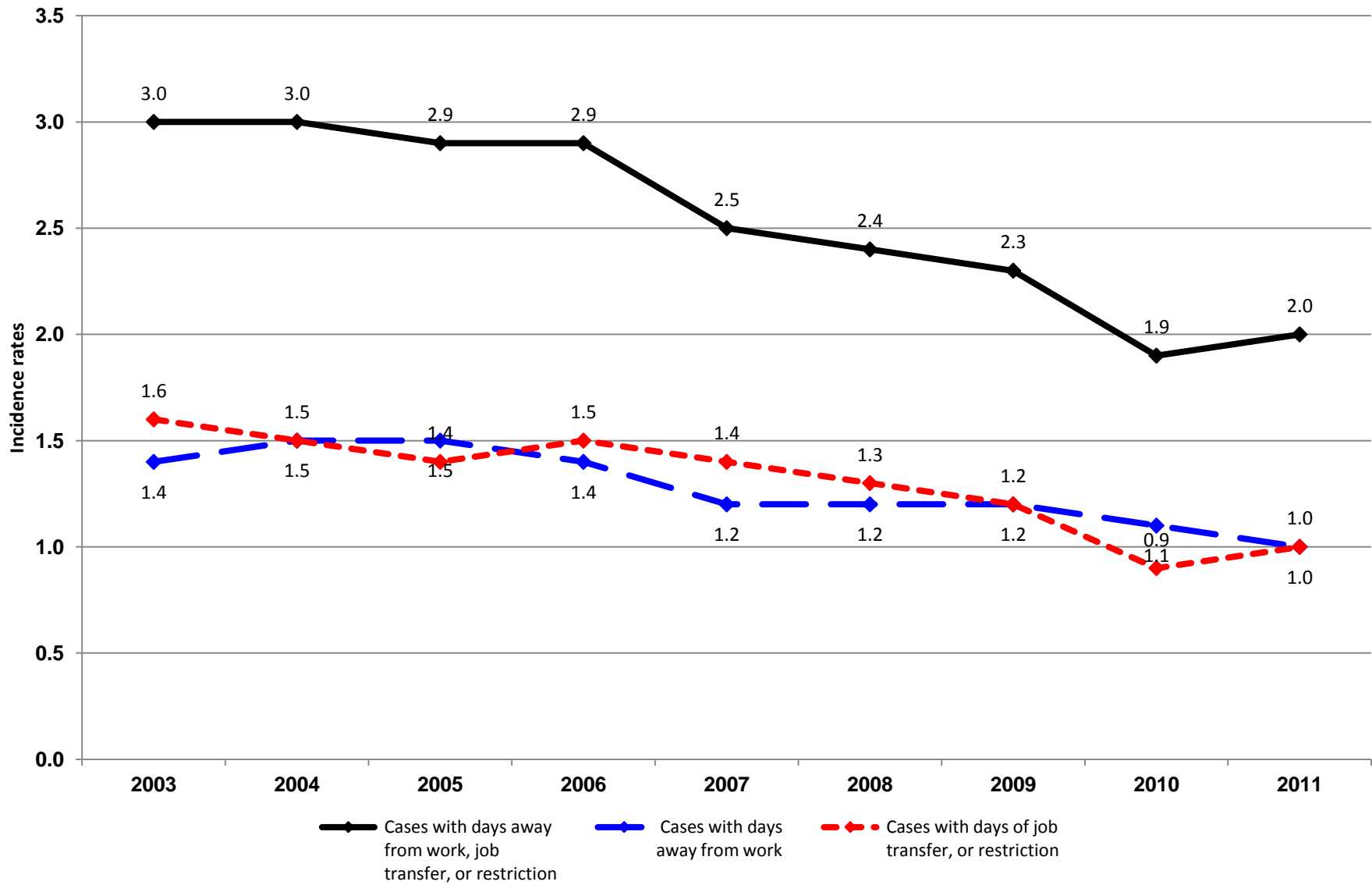


Chart 4. Industries with the highest incidence rates of total nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses, Nevada, 2011
