**Notice of Declaration of Emergency Directive 026 Related to Legal Proceedings, Permits
and Licenses: Nevada Occupational Safety and Health Administration**

In a letter from this agency dated April 2, 2020, we informed you of the Governor's Declaration of Emergency Directive 009 (Revised) concerning the renewal of governmental licenses and permits and the timelines and requirements for legal actions and proceedings during the current State of Emergency. The provisions of Directive 009 (Revised) discussed in the April 2, 2020, notice were terminated in Declaration of Emergency Directive 026 dated June 29, 2020. A copy of Directive 026 is attached to this notice.


SECTION 5 of Directive 026, states, in part:

Directive 009 (Revised) shall terminate on June 30, 2020, at 11:59 pm. All time tolled by Section 2 shall recommence effective July 31, 2020, at 11:59 pm. All licenses and permits issued by the State of Nevada, Boards, Commissions, Agencies, or political subdivisions, that expired between March 12, 2020, and June 30, 2020, because reduced governmental operations due to the state of emergency made timely renewal of the license or permit impracticable or impossible, shall be deemed valid and expire on September 28, 2020, at 11:59 pm. This provision shall not be construed to extend any license within the scope of Directive 011.

The Nevada Occupational Safety and Health Administration of this Division is granting an extension until October 29, 2020, regarding deadlines for the filing of notices of contest. This extension is retroactive to September 1, 2020.

This document is intended solely as notice of the Governor's June 29, 2020, Directive 026, terminating certain Sections of the April 1, 2020, Directive 009 (Revised). It does not include every specific application of this Directive to all the processes of this Division or all of its Sections. This Notice is not legal advice regarding any specific license, permit, or legal proceeding. Please consult an attorney to obtain a legal opinion regarding any specific issue or the effects, if any, this Directive has on any issue.
