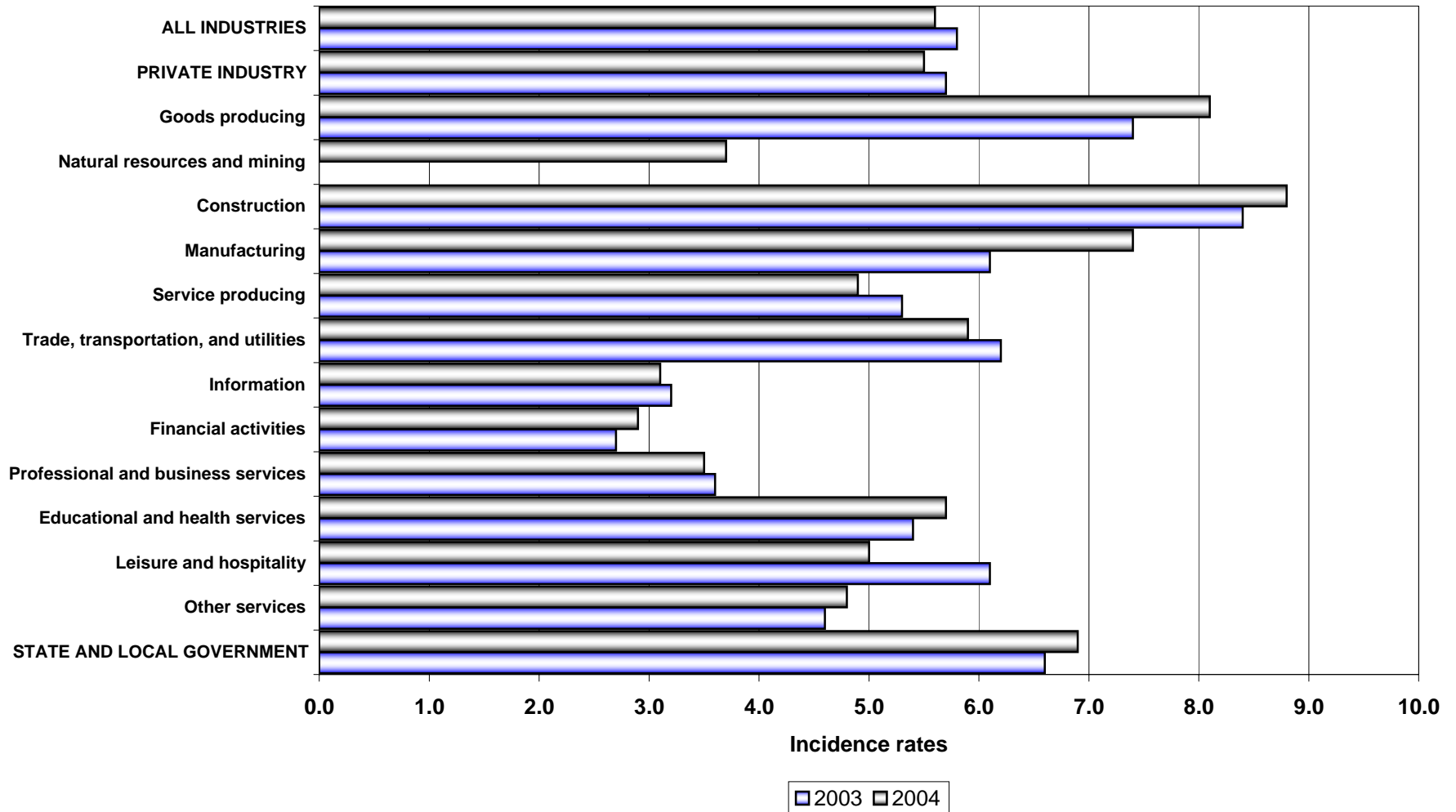
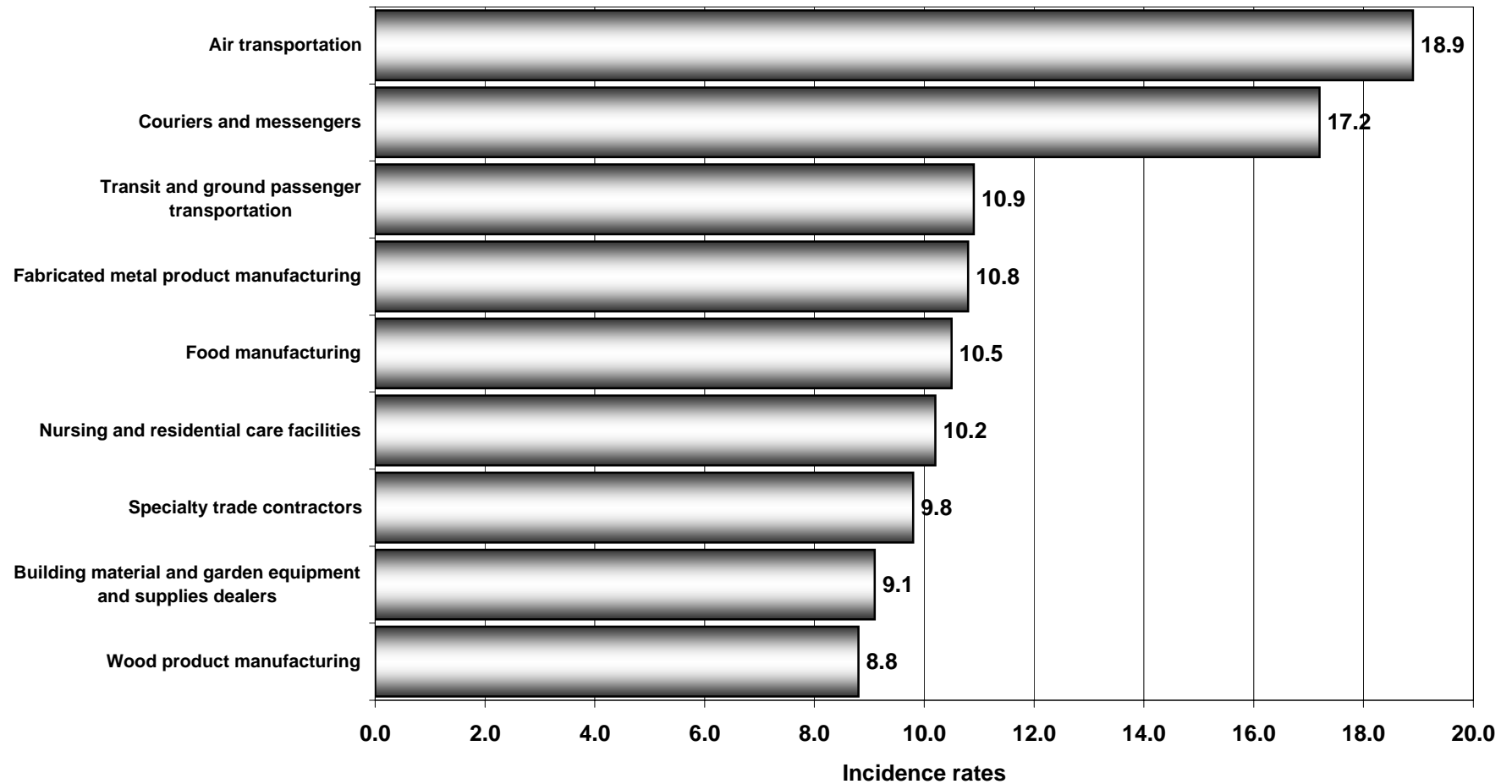

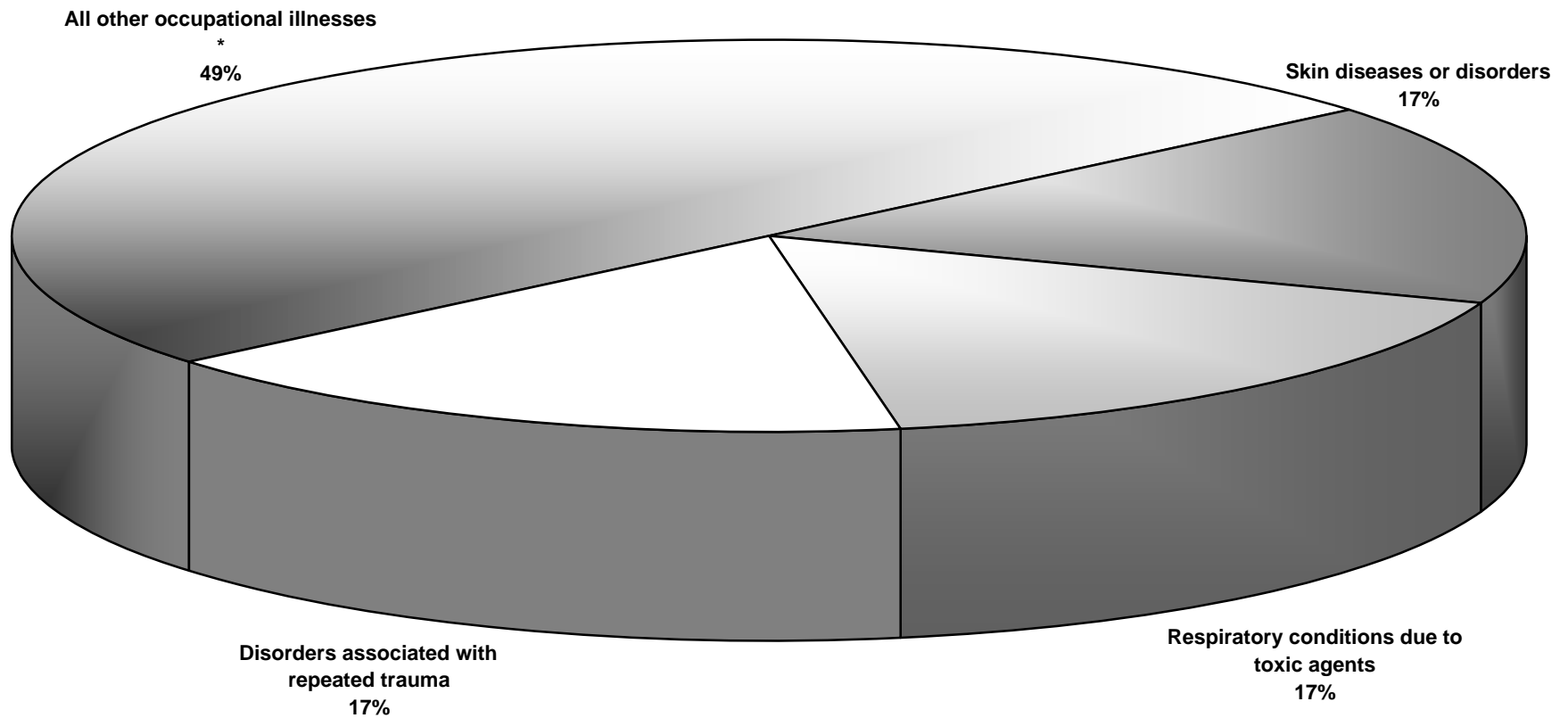

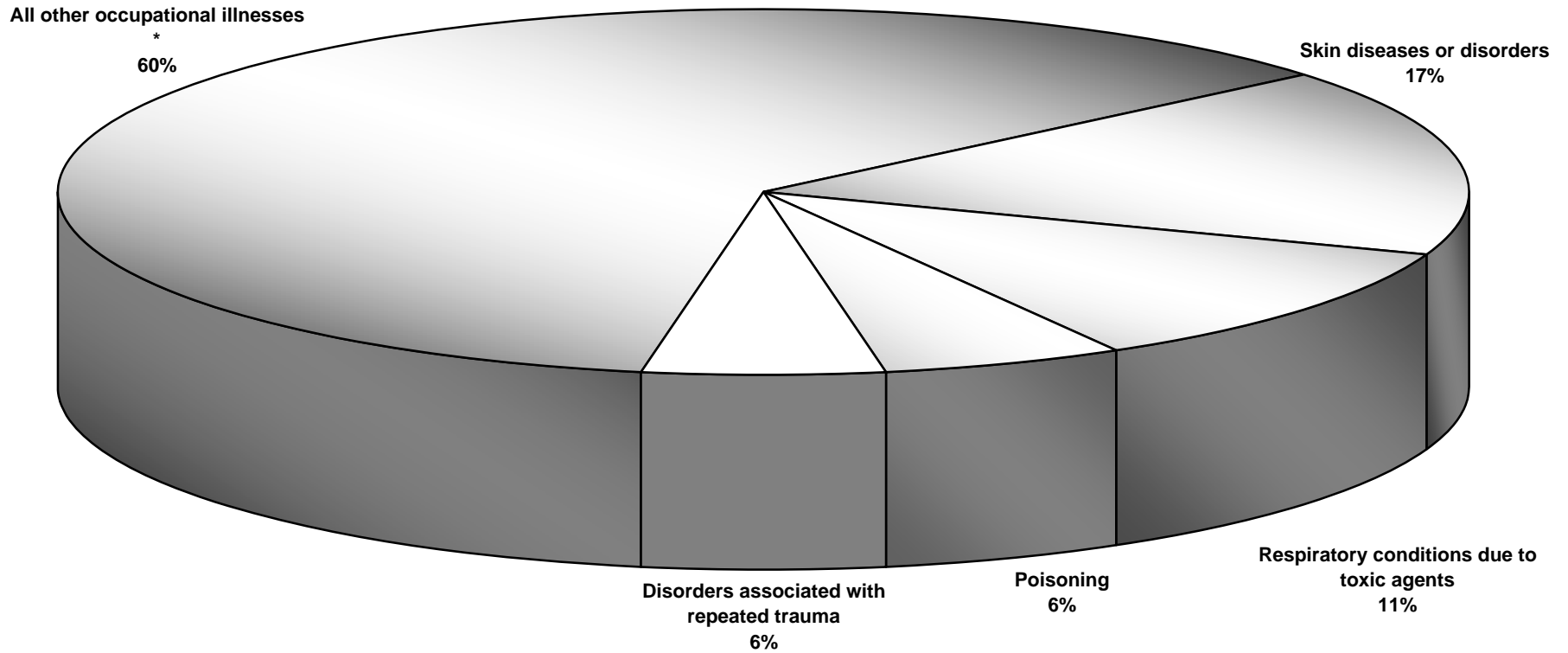
**Chart 5a. Percent distribution of nonfatal occupational illnesses

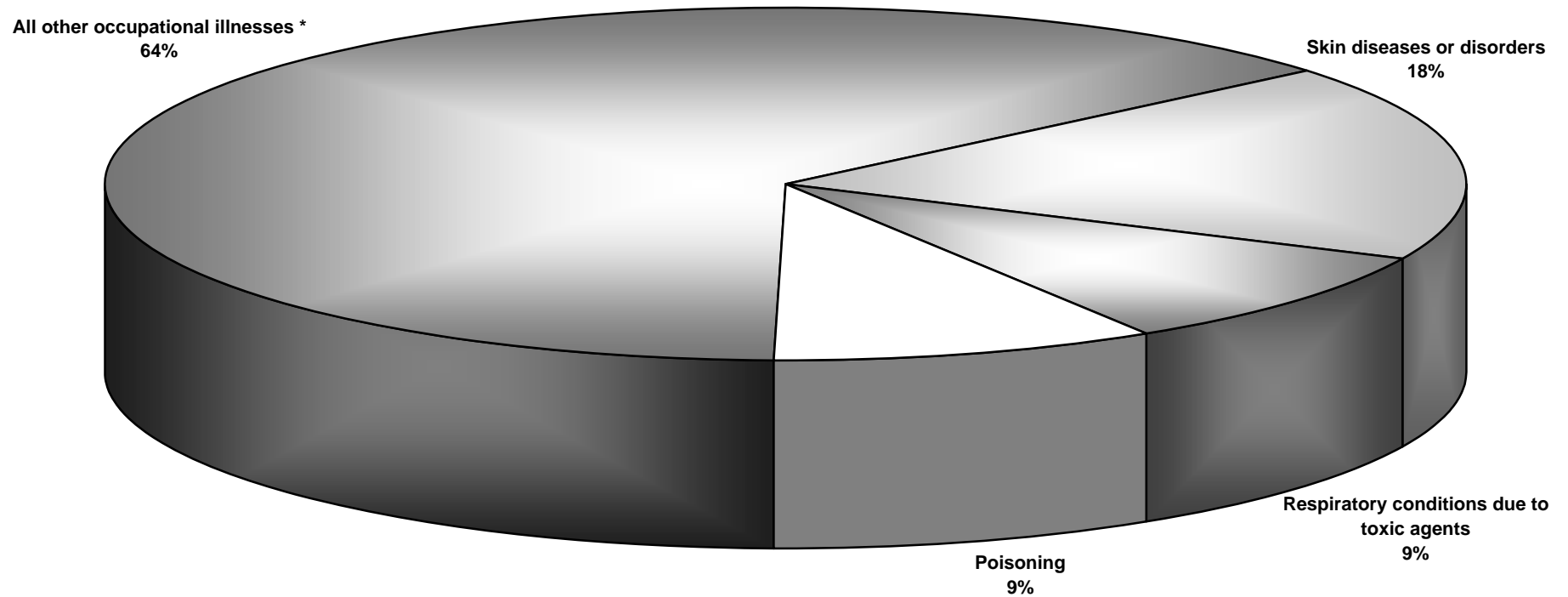
**Chart 5b. Percent distribution of nonfatal occupational illnesses

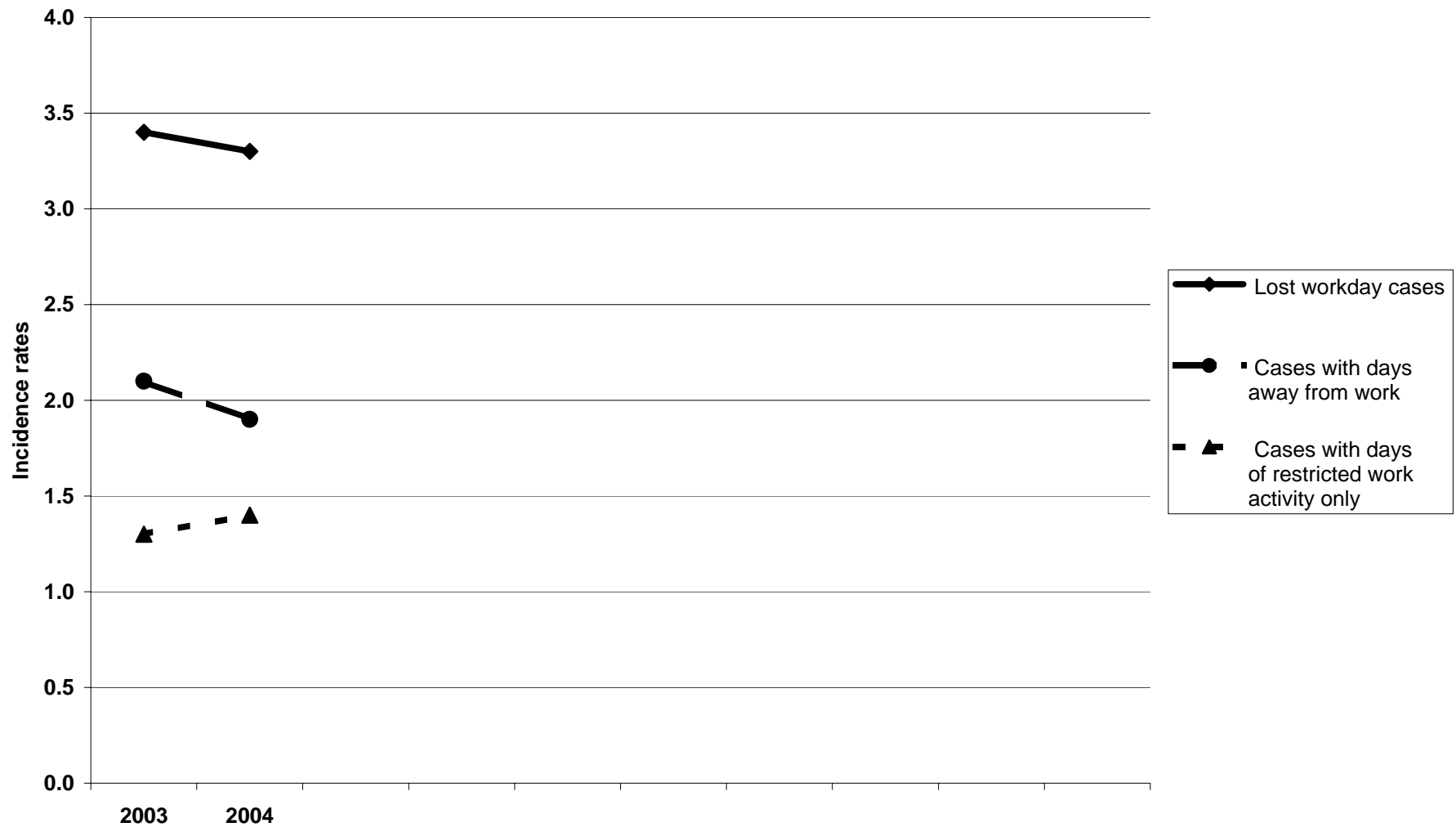
**Chart 5c. Percent distribution of nonfatal occupational illnesses

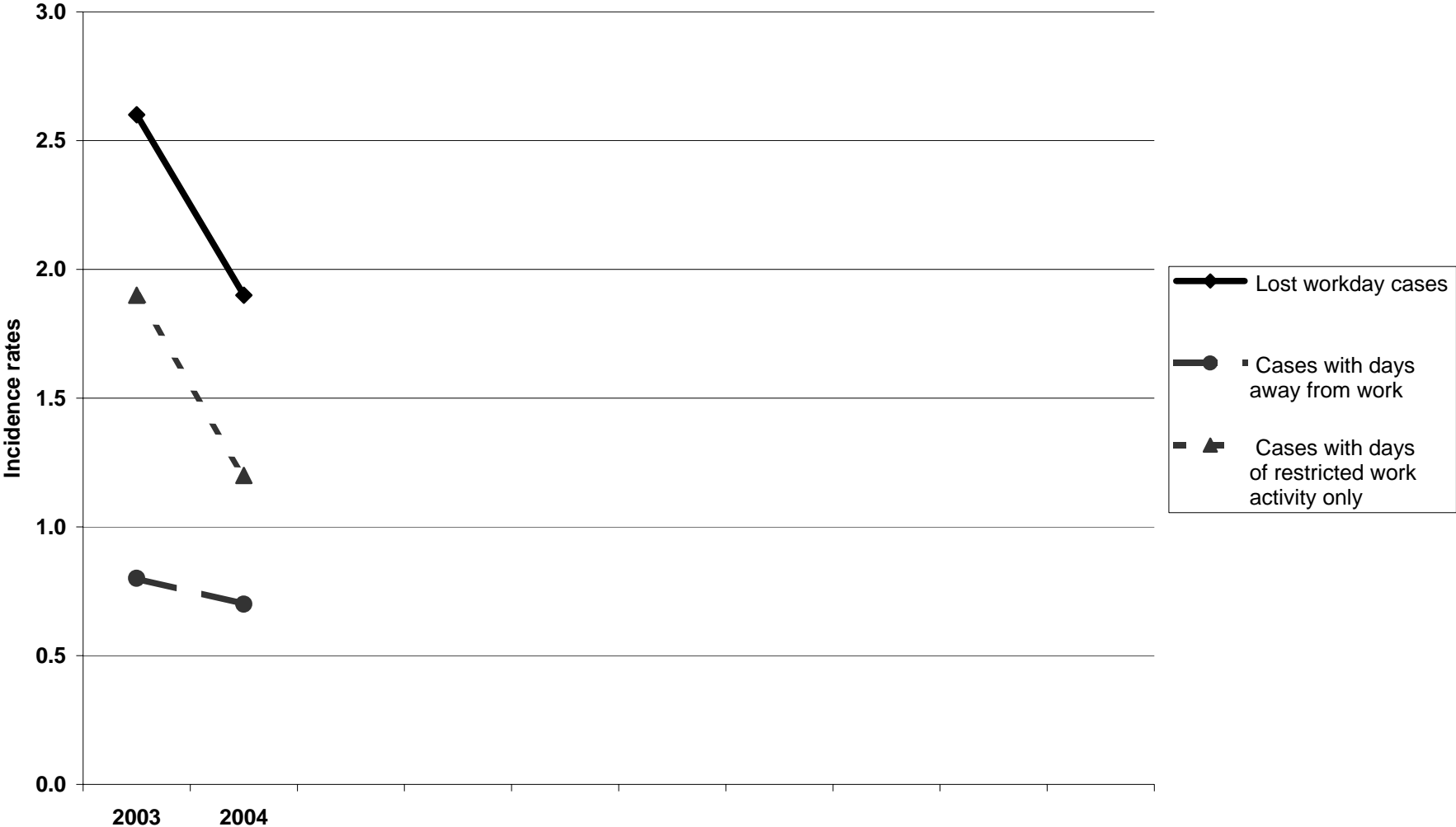

Nevada, local government, 2003-2004**



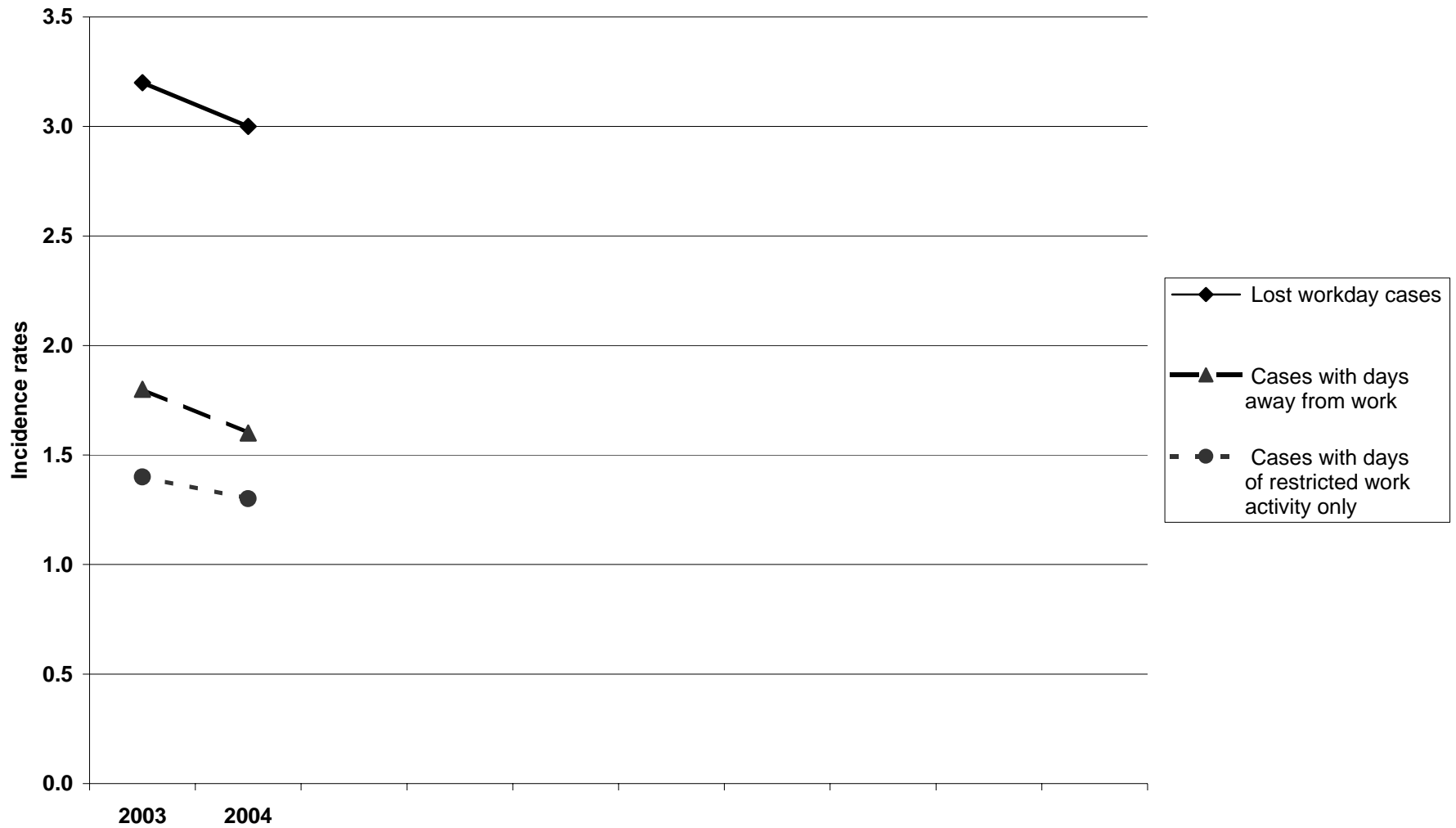

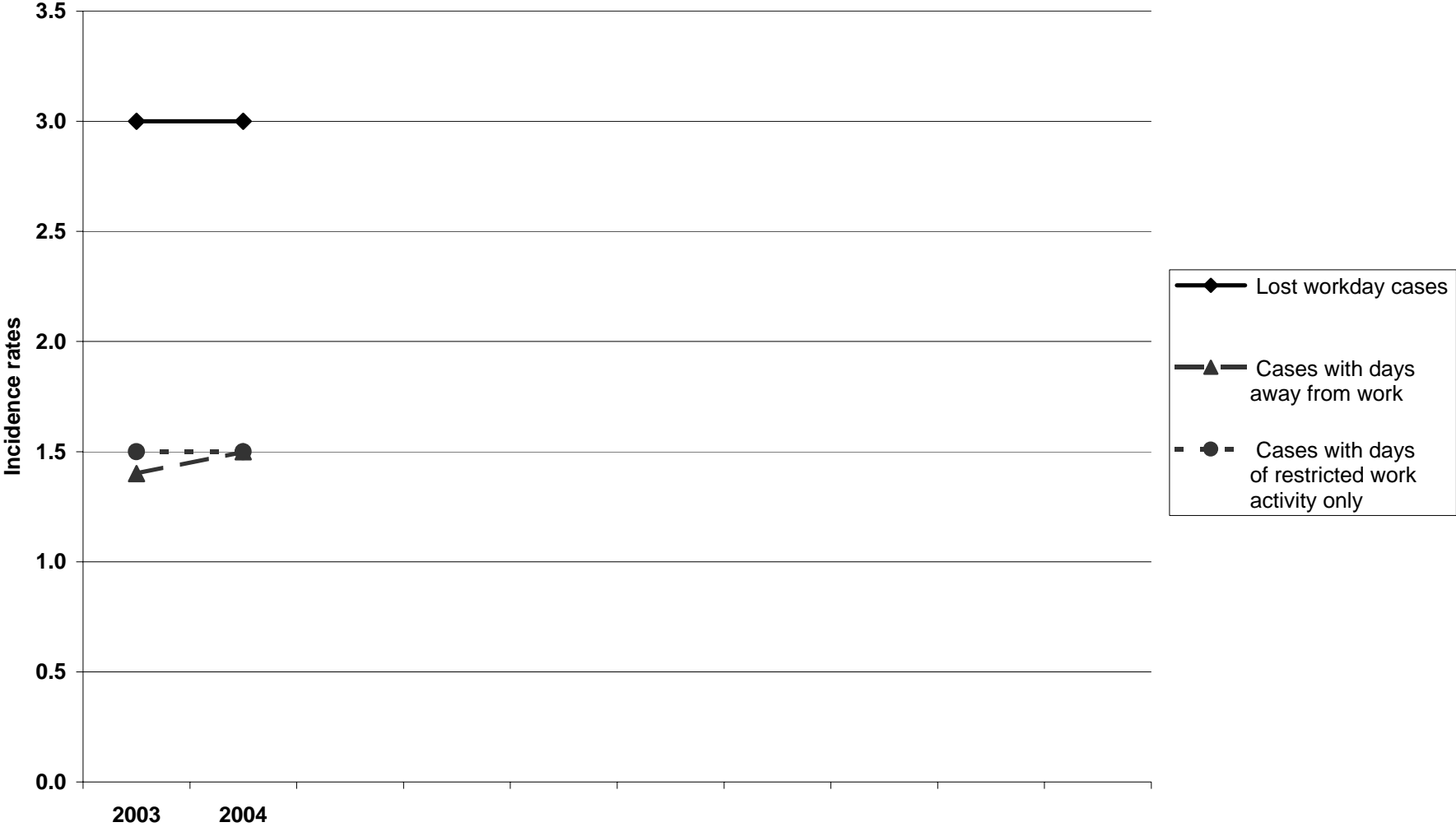
**Chart 6c. Lost workday case incidence rates, injuries and illnesses, Nevada, state and local government, 2003-2004**

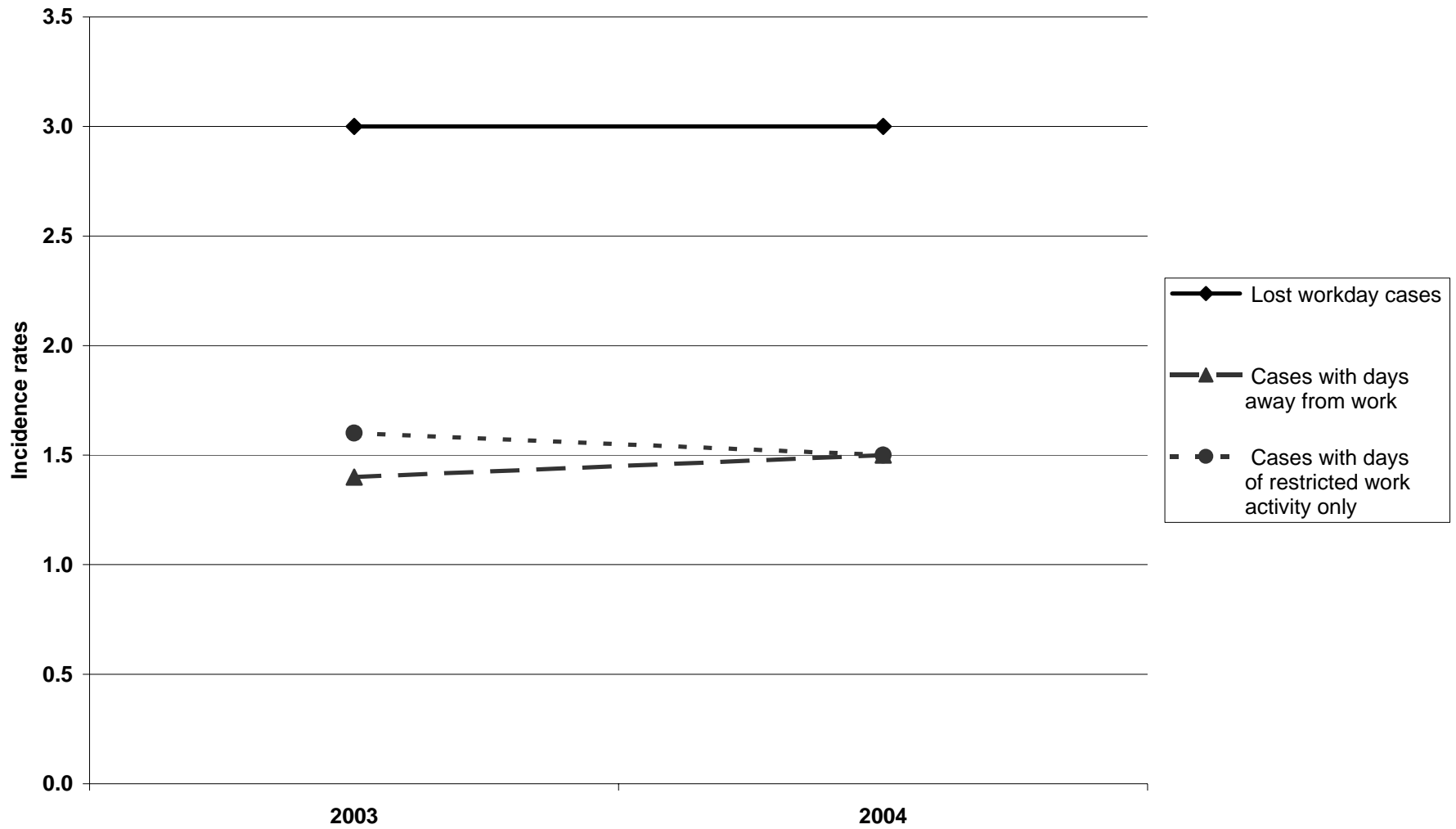


**Chart 6d. Lost workday case incidence rates, injuries and illnesses, Nevada, all industries, 2003-2004**



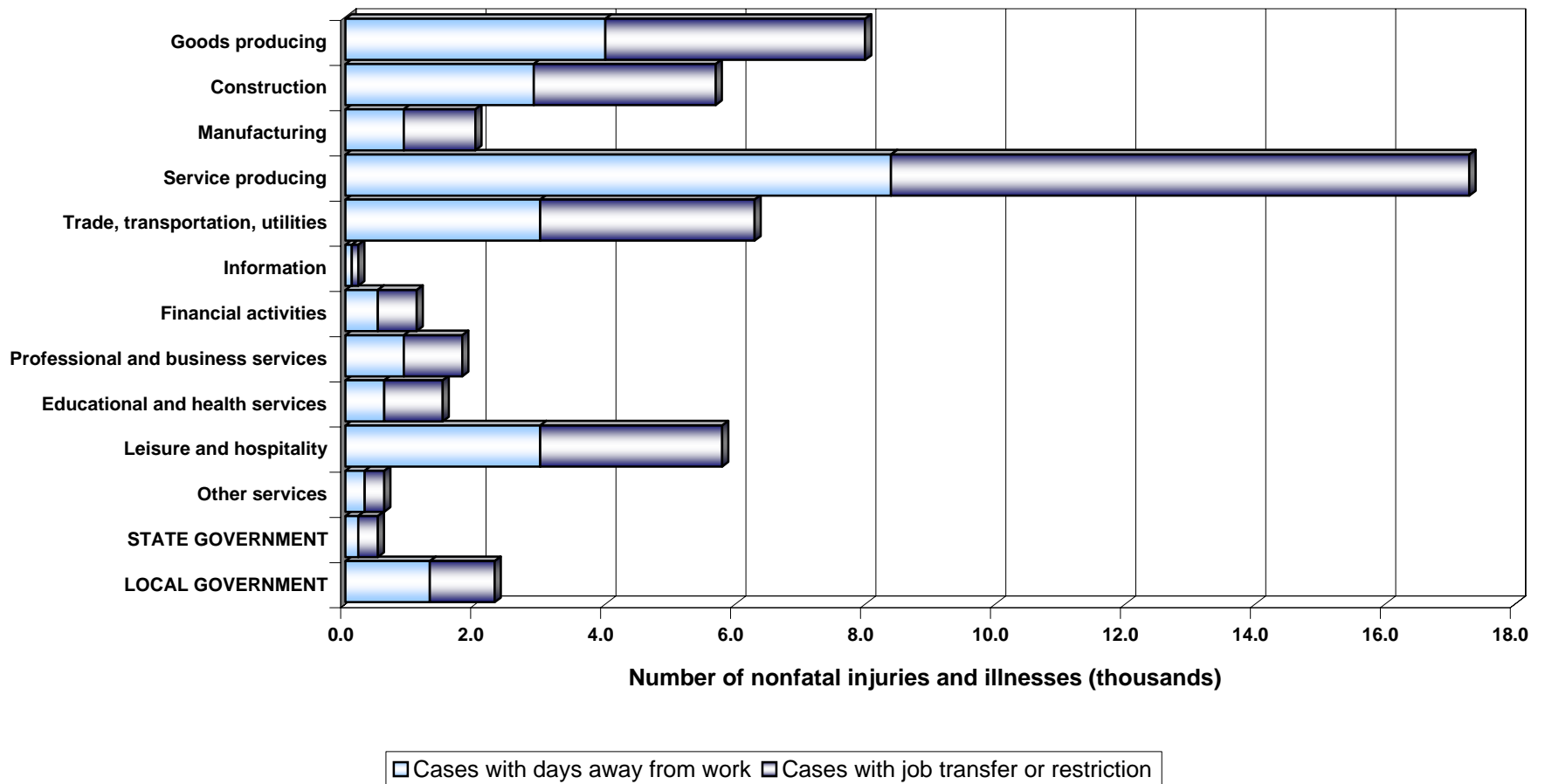
