



**Chart 2. Incidence rates per 100 full-time workers for

Nevada and All United States, 2008**





Nevada, 2007 & 2008**






**Chart 5A. Distribution of illnesses by category of illness,


**Chart 5B. Distribution of illnesses by category of illness,


**Chart 5C. Distribution of illnesses by category of illness,



2008**





Chart 6B. Cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction incidence rates, injuries and illnesses, Nevada, all ownerships, 2003-2008





2008**





Chart 7. Number of cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction, by case type and private major industry sectors, state government, and local government, Nevada, 2008





Chart 8. Incidence rates of Occupational Injuries and Illnesses by Ownership and Case Type, Nevada, 2008




