DIVISION OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS ADVISORY COUNCIL
Minutes of the Meeting, Tuesday, October 03 ,2023

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

At 10:00 a.m. on October 03, 2023, the meeting of the Advisory Council for the Division of Industrial Relations (DIR) was called to order by Chairman Paul McKenzie. Roll Call was taken by Marisa Santizo. Paul McKenzie, Jeff Seavey, Susan Martinez, Vincent Saavedra, and Ian Langtry attended via WebEx. Maureen Ostby attended in person at the Las Vegas Office. It was determined a quorum was present. DIR staff present at the Las Vegas Office were Victoria Carreon, Valerie Hall, Todd Schultz, Justin Taruc, Brennan Paterson, William Gardner, and Marisa Santizo. Rodney Neils attended the meeting at the Carson City office. Sam Taylor from the Attorney General's Office attended via WebEx.

2. Public Comment on items to which actions may be taken

No items for public comment were raised.

3. Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting – July 11, 2023. Vince Saavedra made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 11, 2023, meeting as presented. Susan Martinez seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

4. FOR DISCUSSION: Division of Industrial Relations Activity Update

a. Administrator's Update (Victoria Carreon)

Administrator Carreon discussed how State regulations were adopted by the Legislative Commission. She also discussed that there will be three new positions and recruitment will be starting soon.

b. Mechanical Compliance Section-MCS (Brennan Paterson)

Brennan Paterson discussed some of the upcoming projects for MCS such as Fontainebleau, Formula 1, MSG Sphere, and the Durango Casino. Another major accomplishment for the Mechanical Compliance section was that changes to NAC 455C were approved in August 2023.

c. Mine Safety and Training Section-MSATS (Rodney Neils)

Rodney Neils gave an update on the Mine Safety and Training Section and discussed that staff in Winnemucca participated in the 36th Annual Nevada Safety Olympiad Competition.

d. Occupational Safety and Health Administration-OSHA (William Gardner)

William Gardner stated that Nevada OSHA adopted Federal OSHA's National Emphasis Program (NEP) on Falls and Warehousing. He also mentioned Nevada OSHA will be conducting its annual audit of casefiles to ensure objectives are being met and accountability is being maintained.

e. Safety Consultation and Training Section-SCATS (Todd Schultz)

Todd shared outreach event highlights for SCATS in 2023. Another major highlight was that SCATS partnered with Foundation for Recovery and offered a one-hour presentation that focused on mental wellness.

f. Worker's Compensation-WCS (Valerie Hall)

Valerie spoke about the success of the 11th Annual Nevada Workers' Compensation Educational conference that was held in Las Vegas. She also shared current WCS accomplishments in FY 2023 such as Employer Compliance Unit bringing more than 62% of Nevada employers without workers' compensation coverage into compliance with mandatory coverage provisions.

5. Regulations Update

a. Regulations Approved by Legislative Commission August 21, 2023

Attorney Justin Taruc discussed the regulation updates for R034-21RP2, R134-20RA, and R032-21RP3 and announced that all three regulations were approved.

b. Regulations pending with Legislative Council Bureau pursuant to Executive Order 2023-008

Attorney Justin Taruc explained that Executive Order 2023-08 was an order from Governor Lombardo that required agencies to streamline regulations. As a result, R025-23I, R026-23I, R027-23I, and R028-23I were submitted to the Legislative Counsel Bureau (LCB) to start the regulatory process. DIR's Legal department is currently working with the LCB on a final draft for these regulations.

c. Regulations being drafted

Attorney Justin Taruc discussed Workers' Compensation regulatory changes needed for the implementation of SB274 and AB244 from the 2023 Legislative Session. A draft of the proposed regulation was sent to the Legislative Counsel Bureau on September 25, 2023. For the Heat Illness Regulation, the Division held a meeting with stakeholders and are working on completing a draft.

 - Utilize new software tools to reduce the number of boilers and pressure vessels operating without operating permits.



 - New Elko Safety Specialist Position approved during legislative session
 - 498 inspections completed, a 15% increase over previous year
 - Expanded educational and technical assistance outreach, completed over 3200 requests

- Accomplishments in 2023
 - The new program coordinator position that was approved by the Nevada Legislature was filled on 12/4/23.
 - New VPP Star site at Republic Services Beatty Facility was presented in December.
 - Consultation visits – 735 (37,867 employees removed from hazards)
 - Completed the VPP audit of the Tesla Gigafactory
- Goals for 2024
 - Continue to grow our cooperative programs.
 - Improve attendance in our OSHA 10 and 30 hour courses

Item 6: Workers' Compensation Section Activity Update - Valerie Hall

- Accomplishments in 2023
 - Changes to the Claims and Regulatory Data System (CARDS) necessary for compliance with requirements of SB 274 have been implemented.
 - The Employer Compliance Unit (ECU) has increased employer compliance significantly this year, with an increase exceeding 25% in certain areas.
 - Collaborated with the City of North Las Vegas to streamline reporting requirements for new businesses by developing an electronic version of the declaration on the Affirmation of Compliance (Form D-25).
 - Improved communication and collaboration with the Division of Insurance, resulting in new referral processes and streamlined reporting.
 - Key positions have been filled: Compliance Specialist – RN (LV), Audit Unit Chief (CC), Audit Unit Admin. Assistant II (LV), Indexing Unit Admin. Assistant II (CC), two new Benefit Penalty Compliance Audit Investigator IIs (LV)
- Goals for 2024
 - Begin implementing the CARDS enhancements approved during the 2023 Legislative session.
 - Continue to evaluate business processes and improve efficiency.
 - Continue to increase enforcement activity in rural areas.

1. Lefiell Company LLC - Inspection 1647127

Nevada Revised Statutes 618.375(1): Duties of employers. Every employer shall furnish employment and a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees.

At the facility, two sit-down LP powered industrial trucks were available for use, and had been used, without a restraint device or seat belt installed exposing employees to the recognized hazard of being displaced from the truck in the event of an accident in the following instances:

- a. Tailift 25 sit-down powered industrial truck model (FG25c 1712T serial #TC01068 GMT-III).
- b. Toyota sit-down powered industrial truck model (42CFGCU15 serial #67013).

Reference: ANSI/ITSDF B56.1 - 2012, Section 7 - Design and Construction Standards, 7.41 Operator Restraint Systems

Abatement Note: Among other methods, one feasible and acceptable abatement method to correct this hazard is to install a restraint device. Corrected during the inspection: A restraint device was installed.

Proposed Penalty \$4,465.00

2. Allstates Warehousing and Distribution – Inspection 1654639

Nevada Revised Statute 618.375(1): Duties of employers. Every employer shall furnish employment and a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees.

Located on the Purina side of the warehouse, the employer failed to furnish a place of employment which was free from recognized hazards that was likely to cause death or serious physical harm to employees. Employees were observed working nearby on foot and operating forklifts where struck-by hazards existed due to materials being stored on a 3-level steel racking system (15' or more in height) with visible structural damage in the following instances:

- a. Vertical column, bay B36B03.

- b. Vertical column, bay B36B3.
- c. Vertical column, bay M13A.
- d. Vertical column, bay M21A.
- e. Horizontal crossmember, bay M33A.
- f. Vertical column, bay M33A.
- g. Horizontal crossmember, bay N33A.
- h. Vertical column, bay K21A.
- i. Vertical column, bay H16B5.
- j. Vertical column, bay B01A.
- k. Vertical column, bay Q15A.
- l. Vertical column, bay J25B.
- m. Horizontal crossmember, bay H36A.
- n. Vertical column, bay G21B.
- o. Horizontal crossmember, bay A20A.

Reference: ANSI MH16.2 - 1984 Code of Safety Practices for the Use of Industrial and Commercial Steel Storage Racks (1.4.9).
Corrected during the inspection: The employer hired a vendor who specializes in storage racking who replaced all areas of damaged racking.

Proposed Penalty \$9,844.00

3. Post Consumer Brands – Inspection 1682196

Nevada Revised Statute 618.375(1): Duties of employers. Every employer shall furnish employment and a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees.

In the warehouse, by the loading dock at door 13, visible structural damage to the steel rack's frame was observed. The structural damage was on the lower section of one of the vertical columns.

Reference: ANSI MH16.1 - 2012 Specifications for the design, Testing, and Utilization of Industrial Steel Storage Racks (1.4.1 (2) and 1.4.9). Corrected during inspection: The employer removed all products stored in the racks and tagged the rack out of service until it can be removed or replaced.

A feasible abatement method is to follow the Specifications for the design, Testing, and Utilization of Industrial Steel Storage Racks (1.4.1 (2) and 1.4.9). 1.4.1 Owner Maintenance, regularly inspect for damage. If damage is found, immediately isolate the affected area. Have a storage rack design professional evaluate the damage and unload, replace or repair if directed by the professional, any damaged columns, beams, or other structural components to restore the system to at least its original capacity. 1.4.9 Rack Damage.

Upon any visible damage, the pertinent portions of the rack shall be immediately isolated by the user until the damaged portion is evaluated by a storage rack professional. Before allowing the rack to be placed back into service the design professional must certify that the rack system and/or the repaired components have been restored to at least their original design capacity.

Penalty \$7,534.00

4. Alliance Framing Systems – Inspection 1660668

Nevada Revised Statute 618.375(1): Duties of employers. Every employer shall furnish employment and a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees.

The employer failed to provide a place of employment free from recognized hazards, presented by high winds, likely to cause death or serious physical harm to its employees. Employees were engaged in residential framing activities at a jobsite on Robson Ridge Lane constructing new single-family homes. The work included employees manually standing-up wood framed wall sections to make the necessary attachments to secure them in position. Performing this work in windy conditions created recognized serious struck-by hazards in the event the wind caused materials to strike employees. This could result in serious injuries including broken bones and concussions, or death.

On the day of the incident, wind speeds ranged between 8 and 33 miles per hour, with wind gusts as high as 44 miles per hour. A crew of three employees working under supervision were attempting to stand up a framed wall section and secure it to the concrete foundation. The framed wall section being erected measured approximately 27 feet 10 inches wide and 9 feet 2 inches tall. As employees were standing the wall up, the wind caused the employees to lose control of the wall, which subsequently struck an employee's head. The employee succumbed to his injuries and died at the scene.

Reference: Windy conditions are recognized as potentially hazardous by multiple OSHA standards. Additionally, the employer's Foreman on site recognized the hazard presented by the windy conditions but permitted the task of manually standing-up the framed wall section to secure it in position to continue.

One feasible means of abatement is to monitor wind conditions and establish parameters for stopping work, establish a policy, and ensure appropriate staff are trained on the policy.

Establish a written policy for working in high wind conditions that provides options to be taken by the employer when handling materials, such as manually raising framed walls, that includes determining the number of employees necessary to perform a lift, monitoring weather conditions, and establishing what wind speed will be used to suspend operations.

Proposed Penalty \$14,063.00

5. Mirage Builders – Inspection 1664838

Nevada Revised Statute 618.375(1): Duties of employers. Every employer shall furnish employment and a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees.

The employer did not ensure employees were furnished with a place of employment free from recognized hazards that are causing or likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees. On April 20, 2023, at the Project 63 jobsite located at South City Center & Harmon Avenue, Mirage Builders employees utilized a Skyjack SJ111 scissor lift to move bundles of steel studs on the third floor in conjunction with a dolly. The bundle of steel studs was wrapped with a polyester sling strap. One end of the sling was connected to the bundle of steel studs and the other end of the sling was wrapped around an approximate 5-foot-long metal tube placed inside the scissor lift basket against the guard rails to hold it in place. After moving a bundle of studs to the middle of the third-floor work area an employee raised the scissor lift basket approximately 18 feet so the other employees could remove the dolly cart from underneath the studs. At some point during this activity, the scissor lift tipped over and the employee fell to the ground below. The employees were potentially exposed to serious crush-by injuries and the employee operating the scissor lift sustained serious physical injuries including a fractured ankle and contusions.

References: ANSI/SIA A92.6 - 2006 for Self-Propelled Elevating Work Platforms, 7.10 Operator warnings and instructions. The user shall direct personnel operating the aerial platform to be in compliance with the provisions set forth in section 8 of this standard. The user shall monitor their performance and supervise their work to ensure the use, application and operation of the aerial platform is in conformance with the provisions set forth in this standard, warn personnel of potential hazards, provide means to protect against identified hazards, and explain the potential consequences of not following proper operating guidelines. Instructions and guidelines regarding proper operation shall include, but not necessarily be limited to the following issues and subjects: (20) Misuse as a crane. The aerial platform shall not be used as a crane.

Operating Manual (ANSI/CSA) DC Electric Scissors Models SJIII 3226, Section 1, Safety Rules, Warning: Failure to heed the following safety precautions could result in tip over, falling, crushing, or other hazards leading to death or serious injury. Do not use the aerial platform as a crane. It is prohibited.

A feasible means of abatement would be for the employer to ensure bundles of steel studs are transported by equipment designed for that purpose.

Proposed Penalty \$7,813.00

6. The Tuff Shed, Inc. – Inspection 1668802

NRS 618.375 (1) Duties of Employers. Furnish employment and a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees.

The employer did not ensure employees were furnished with a place of employment free from recognized hazards that are causing or likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees. At the Door Station area, an employee operated a Toyota IC Pneumatic Forklift (Model 8FGU30, Serial No. 39362) to load and unload lumber from a storage rack. The storage rack was not anchored down to the floor. Employees were potentially exposed to serious crush-by injuries in the event of inadvertent contact between the forklift and the storage rack.

Reference: ANSI MH16.1: 2012 Specification for the Design, Testing and Utilization of Industrial Steel Storage Racks. Section 1.4.7 Column Base Plates and Anchors. The bottom of all columns shall be furnished with column base plates, as specified in Section 7.1. All rack columns shall be anchored to the floor with the anchor bolts, which shall be designed in accordance with Section 7.3, to resist all applicable forces as described in Section 2.1 and Section 2.2.

Proposed Penalty \$4,018.00

7. Four Queens LLC – Inspection 1672433

Nevada Revised Statute 618.375(1): Duties of employers. Every employer shall furnish employment and a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees.

The employer did not ensure employees were furnished with a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his or her employees. In the receiving area, an employee utilized a Crown 3000 series Electric Pallet Jack (Model: WP3035-45 Series No. 7A326587) to move boxes of beer and liquor. Three storage racks were not anchored down to the floor. The employee was potentially exposed to serious crush-by injuries in the event of inadvertent contact between the electric pallet jack and the storage racks.

Reference: ANSI MH16.1: 2012 Specification for the Design, Testing and Utilization of Industrial Steel Storage Racks. Section 1.4.7 Column Base Plates and Anchors. The bottom of all columns shall be furnished with column base plates, as specified in Section 7.1. All rack columns shall be anchored to the floor with the anchor bolts, which shall be designed in accordance with Section 7.3, to resist all applicable forces as described in Section 2.1 and Section 2.2.
