And, 12 Vanessa, I'll take you up on your offer to go ahead and 13 get that done. 14 MS. SKRINJARIC: Okay. Bryan Wachter? 15 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Present. 16 MS. SKRINJARIC: Rebecca Fountain? 17 BOARD MEMBER FOUNTAIN: Present. 18 MS. SKRINJARIC: Allen Walker? 19 BOARD MEMBER WALKER: Present. 20 21 MS. SKRINJARIC: Joyce Smith? BOARD MEMBER SMITH: Present. 2.2 MS. SKRINJARIC: This is Vanessa Skrinjaric for 23 the DIR. 24

Donald Bordelove? 1 MR. BORDELOVE: Present. 2 MS. SKRINJARIC: Christopher Eccles? 3 MR. ECCLES: Present. 4 5 MS. SKRINJARIC: And present for Mr. Balkenbush, we have John Hooks? 6 MR. HOOKS: Correct, present. 7 MS. SKRINJARIC: Okay. And present for 8 9 Mr. Staub, we have Larae Polson for ARMI? MS. POLSON: Present. 10 MS. SKRINJARIC: Okay. And, I believe, that's 11 all that we have present at the time. 12 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Thank you, ma'am. 13 Is there anybody else on the call that we may 14 have missed? 15 Okay. With that, we'll move into agenda item 16 number 2, public comment. 17 Anybody in the public wishing to speak now? 18 Hearing none, we'll move to agenda item 19 number 3, approval of the agenda. 20 Fellow Board members, Vanessa had this in an 21 email. It's been posted. Are there any changes or 2.2 discussions on the agenda? 23 BOARD MEMBER FOUNTAIN: None. 24

1 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. Hearing none, then we'll entertain a motion to approve the agenda. 2 BOARD MEMBER SMITH: Motion to approve. 3 BOARD MEMBER FOUNTAIN: Motion to approve. 4 5 BOARD MEMBER SMITH: Joyce. BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: I have a motion from 6 Joyce to approve the agenda and a second from Rebecca. 7 Any discussion? 8 9 All those in favor say "aye." (Board members said "aye.") 10 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Any opposed? 11 12 Motion passes. We'll move on to item number 4, which is the 13 approval of the minutes. 14 There was a bit of confusion. Vanessa outdid 15 herself. She put it to us twice, once this morning. 16 17 But just for the record, it was included in your original data packet that we got last month. 18 So are there any questions or discussion on the 19 minutes? 20 21 Okay. Hearing none, we'll entertain a motion to approve the minutes for June 18, 2020. 2.2 BOARD MEMBER SMITH: Joyce Smith. Motion to 23 24 approve.

BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: I've got a motion from 1 Is there a second? Joyce. 2 BOARD MEMBER WALKER: 3 Second. BOARD MEMBER FOUNTAIN: Second. Go ahead, 4 5 Allen. BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. Moved by Joyce to 6 approve the minutes for June 18, 2020, second by Allen. 7 All those in favor, say "aye." 8 9 (Board members said "aye.") 10 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Any opposed? 11 Motion passes. We will move on to agenda item number 5, action 12 on the recommendation. We've got three supplemental 13 requests for approval today, the first one being a., 14 case number C143-10-05247-01, for Douglas County. 15 And I'll turn it over to you, Vanessa. 16 17 MS. SKRINJARIC: Okay. It is the Administrator's recommendation to accept this second 18 19 supplemental request pursuant to NRS 616B.578 for the lumbar spine. 20 21 The total amount requested for reimbursement is \$73,951.71. The amount of reimbursement, after costs 2.2 were verified, is \$71,271.17. An explanation of the 23 disallowance is attached to this recommendation memo. 24

This request was received from Robert 1 Balkenbush, Esq. on May 12th, 2020. This claim was 2 originally approved by the Board on November 20th, 2014. 3 This request contained reporting and/or payment 4 for the following expenses: 5 Pain management appointments with Dr. Goode's 6 office from February 21, 2017 through September 26, 7 2019; 8 9 Office visits with Dr. Fry's office on March 7, 2017, April 12th, 2017, April 26th, 2017 and 10 November 29, 2018; 11 IME with Dr. Bassewitz on January 25th, 2019 12 and follow-up report on May 2nd, 2019; 13 FCE on June 10th, 2019; 14 Lumbar spine MRI on March 17, 2017 and 15 September 9, 2019; 16 17 Drug screening on May 30th, 2017, November 16, 2017, June 28th, 2018, December 18, 2018, May 9, 2019 18 and September 26, 2019; 19 Prescriptions from February 4th, 2017 through 20 21 January 10th, 2020; PPD review with Dr. Betz on October 9th, 2019; 2.2 and 23 PPD award of 5 percent paid in a lump sum on 24

1 November 22nd, 2019.

2	On January 12th, 2017, the injured employee had
3	right total hip arthroplasty for avascular necrosis.
4	this was done on a nonindustrial basis. The employee
5	continued to see Dr. Goode for pain management.
6	However, he had ongoing complaints of back pain
7	radiating into his right thigh. Dr. Fry recommended an
8	IME to determine if the pain was related to his back or
9	his hip.
10	On January 25th, 2019, Dr. Bassewitz performed
11	an IME. He recommended L2-3 epidural steroid
12	injections. He felt the only thing that would improve
13	the employee's condition was a thoracolumbar
14	reconstruction with multiple interbody grafts and
15	potential osteotomies. The employee did not want to
16	undergo this surgery. The employee understood he would
17	be living with chronic pain.
18	On May 2nd, 2019, Dr. Bassewitz was asked to
19	clarify his IME. Specifically, the L2-3 spinal stenosis
20	was related to a prior underlying biological disc
21	degeneration and not related to the subject injury or
22	laminectomy.
23	Based on Dr. Bassewitz's supplemental, the
24	insurer did not approve the epidural steroid injections.

1 The employee continued to treat with Dr. Goode where he received MS Contin, Oxycodone and Lyrica. 2 He also routinely underwent urine drug testing. On 3 February 14, 2019, Dr. Goode noted the employee's drug 4 5 tests show significant amounts of alcohol. Dr. Goode changed the employee's medication from Oxycodone to 6 Dilaudid. 7 On June 10th, 2019, an FCE was done which 8 9 showed the employee is unable to perform his preinjury job. No vocational rehabilitation documents were 10 submitted for reimbursement with this submission. 11 On August 23rd, 2019, a PPD evaluation was 12 performed by Dr. Black, who found an 11 percent whole 13 person impairment using the range of motion method. Не 14 subtracted a prior 9 percent whole person impairment --15 this was incorrect -- leaving a net 2 percent whole 16 17 person impairment. On October 9th, 2019, Dr. Betz performed a PPD 18 19 record review. He felt the employee fell into DRE Lumbar Category III, giving him the maximum of 20 21 13 percent whole person impairment. He then subtracted the prior stipulated 7 percent for the same spinal 2.2 segment, leaving a net 5 percent whole person 23

24 impairment. The employee took this in a lump sum.

1 The employee continues to see Dr. Goode for pain management. He is currently taking Oxycodone 2 10 milligrams, Morphine Sulfate 15 milligrams and 3 Pregabalin 150 milligrams. 4 5 And that is all. BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Thank you, Vanessa. 6 Mr. Hooks, is there anything that you would 7 like to add to the record? 8 9 MR. HOOKS: No, thank you. 10 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: I appreciate that. Anything from Chris or Don? 11 MR. ECCLES: Not from me, thank you. 12 MR. BORDELOVE: Nothing from Don. 13 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. So, then, we'll 14 turn it over to the Board. Any questions, discussion 15 from Board members? 16 17 BOARD MEMBER SMITH: No, sir. Okay. Well, then, hearing none, we'll accept a 18 19 motion for -- I just lost it -- case number C143-10-05247-01 in the amount of \$71,271.17. 20 Does 21 somebody want to make that motion? BOARD MEMBER SMITH: I make the motion. 2.2 Joyce. BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: I've got a motion from 23 Do I have a second? Joyce. 24

1 BOARD MEMBER WALKER: Second. BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: I've got a second from 2 Allen. It's been moved and seconded to approve the 3 reimbursement for a total of \$71,271.17. Any final 4 5 discussion from the Board? Okay. All those in favor, say "aye." 6 (Board members said "aye.") 7 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Any opposed? 8 9 Motion passes. 10 We'll move on to agenda 5.b., case C143-03-01086-01, for Mineral County. And I'll turn it 11 back over to you, Vanessa. 12 MS. SKRINJARIC: Okay. It is the 13 Administrator's recommendation to accept this second 14 supplemental request pursuant to NRS 616B.578 for the 15 heart, i.e. myocardial infarction and coronary artery 16 disease. 17 The total amount requested for reimbursement is 18 19 \$61,507.69. The amount of reimbursement, after costs were verified, is \$61,401.80. An explanation of the 20 disallowance is attached to this recommendation memo. 21 This request was received from Robert 2.2 Balkenbush, Esq. on June 19, 2020. This claim was 23 originally approved by the Board on July 15th, 2014. 24

1	This request contained payment and/or reporting
2	for the following expenses:
3	Office visits with Dr. Arger for cardiac
4	follow-up on April 30th, 2019 and September 9th, 2019;
5	Prescriptions from January 16, 2019 through
6	August 29th, 2019; and
7	Permanent total disability payments from
8	August 1, 2018 through April 30th, 2020. This gentleman
9	qualifies for the yearly increase and his PPD payments
10	are being reduced by 10 percent for a prior PPD award.
11	The file contained permanent total disability reports of
12	employment, Form D-14, from 2018 through 2019.
13	On September 9th, 2019, the patient reported to
14	Dr. Arger that he had recent biopsies of his left lung
15	after a CT scan showed a small mass and it was negative.
16	The patient is now taking iron pills after some recent
17	lab work. He also complains of fatigue. Medications
18	were reviewed. It appears the patient follows up every
19	six months.
20	That is all.
21	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Thank you, Vanessa. I'm
22	very glad that his test came back negative there.
23	Any questions or any comments from you,
24	Mr. Hooks?

1	MR. HOOKS: No. No. Thank you.
2	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Mr. Don?
3	MR. BORDELOVE: No, sir.
4	MR. ECCLES: None from me.
5	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Then, we'll turn it over
6	to the Board. Any questions or comments, questions from
7	the Board?
8	BOARD MEMBER SMITH: No, sir.
9	BOARD MEMBER FOUNTAIN: None.
10	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. In that case,
11	we'll seek a motion to approve a reimbursement in the
12	total of \$61,401.80 in the case of C143-03-01086-01. Is
13	there a motion?
14	BOARD MEMBER WALKER: Motion to approve.
15	BOARD MEMBER FOUNTAIN: This is Rebecca.
16	Second.
17	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: I've got a motion from
18	Allen and a second from Rebecca. Any comment from the
19	Board?
20	All those in favor, say "aye."
21	(Board members said "aye.")
22	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Any opposed?
23	Motion passes. Thank you.
24	And now we will go to item 5.c., case

5001-0871-2008-0446, for Hoss Disposal, Incorporated. 1 2 Vanessa. MS. SKRINJARIC: Okay. It is the 3 Administrator's recommendation to --4 5 BOARD MEMBER WALKER: Pardon me, Vanessa, just one second. I have to recuse --6 MS. SKRINJARIC: Oh. 7 BOARD MEMBER WALKER: -- recuse myself from 8 9 this one, because it's Nevada Transportation. 10 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: I apologize, Allen. I should have caught that. 11 BOARD MEMBER WALKER: Not a problem. 12 MS. SKRINJARIC: And sorry about that. 13 Okay. It is the Administrator's recommendation 14 to accept this second supplemental request pursuant to 15 NRS 616B.578 for the left knee. 16 17 The total amount requested for reimbursement is \$23,329.72. The amount of reimbursement, after costs 18 were verified, is \$23,329.72. 19 This request was received from Associated Risk 20 Management, Inc. on June 18th, 2020. This request 21 contained documentation and/or payment for the following 2.2 23 expenses: Permanent partial disability installment 24

1	payments in the monthly amount of \$306.97 from
2	March 28th, 2013 through July 26, 2019.
3	This gentleman received monthly PPD installment
4	payments until he reached 70 years old. No further PPD
5	payments are due. The last submission for this claim
6	was in December 2012.
7	That's all.
8	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Thank you, Vanessa.
9	Ms. Larae, do you have anything to add?
10	MS. POLSON: No, thank you.
11	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: And just to
12	double-check, Mr. Balkenbush didn't jump on? Okay.
13	MR. HOOKS: No, no. It's still John Hooks for
14	the remainder of the meeting.
15	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Oh, I apologize. You
16	have this, you have this client as well?
17	MR. HOOKS: No, I do not. I was just you
18	mentioned my name.
19	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Oh, okay.
20	MR. HOOKS: So I thought I'd clarify that.
21	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Oh, I meant Mr. Staub.
22	I apologize. Yes, I apologize there. I'm getting
23	confused on myself.
24	Okay. Well, with that, Chris, anything from

1 you? MR. ECCLES: No, sir. Thank you. 2 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Don? 3 MR. BORDELOVE: No. 4 5 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. Any questions from the Board? 6 BOARD MEMBER FOUNTAIN: None. 7 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. Then, in case 8 9 5001-0871-2008-0446, we'll entertain a motion to approve reimbursement for a total of \$23,329.72. Is there a 10 motion? 11 12 BOARD MEMBER FOUNTAIN: Motion to approve. BOARD MEMBER SMITH: Joyce Smith. Second. 13 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: I've got a motion to 14 approve by Rebecca. I've got a second by Joyce. And 15 Allen has recused himself. All those in favor, say 16 17 "aye." (Board members said "aye.") 18 19 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Any opposed? 20 The motion passes, three approval, one 21 abstention. Thank you very much for that. And thank you, Vanessa, for your help there. 2.2 Agenda item number 6.a., general matters of 23 concern to the Board. Any member of the Board have 24

1 anything to add here? 2 Okay. BOARD MEMBER WALKER: No. 3 BOARD MEMBER SMITH: No. 4 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: 6.b., old and new 5 business. We start with Vanessa. Anything to add? 6 MS. SKRINJARIC: Not at this time. 7 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. Don, anything 8 9 from you? MR. HOOKS: I'm sorry to interject, one thing. 10 Did we cover 5.b., the ending in 1086, for Mineral 11 County? 12 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: We did, yes, sir. 13 MR. HOOKS: Okay. Good. Thank you. 14 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: M-hm (affirmative). 15 Don, anything for 6.b.? 16 17 MR. BORDELOVE: Nothing from me. BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Chris? 18 MR. ECCLES: No, sir. Thank you. 19 BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. Then, on 6.c., we 20 21 will schedule our next meeting. Or we have scheduled the next meeting. 2.2 Vanessa, what does the docket look like? 23 MS. SKRINJARIC: I currently do not have 24

1	anything pending. So we are good to skip September for
2	sure. Obviously, I know we'll be here for October. But
3	if I recall, Mr. Bordelove is going to have some
4	conflicts.
5	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Okay. Are we in a
6	position to be able to square those conflicts today, or
7	is that something you guys need to work on?
8	MS. SKRINJARIC: Donald, I think, you're okay
9	for October. Is that correct?
10	MR. BORDELOVE: Yeah, I'm fine for October.
11	MS. SKRINJARIC: Okay. The issue then becomes
12	November and December, correct?
13	MR. BORDELOVE: Right, right. I have hearings
14	on both of those days.
15	MS. SKRINJARIC: Okay. So, I think, we've been
16	doing pretty good with going every other month. So at
17	this time, if the Board wants to cancel the November, we
18	would then have to just deal with the December conflict.
19	BOARD MEMBER WACHTER: Why don't we do this,
20	Vanessa. Let's go ahead. We'll keep the October date.
21	We'll cancel November and December. And then we'll plan
22	on scheduling a new meeting that we could announce on
23	October 22nd to cover the November, December time
24	period. So like I'm thinking like maybe even like the
