NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP PER EXECUTIVE ORDER 2026-003

The Division of Industrial Relations of the Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada ("Division"), through the Workers' Compensation Section ("WCS"), hereby provides notice of a public workshop concerning Governor Lombardo's Executive Order 2026-003. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments and recommendations from interested persons and stakeholders regarding the Division's existing regulations contained in Chapters 616A through 617, inclusive, of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"), and whether those regulations may be appropriate for streamlining, clarification, revision, or removal and to identify other regulatory changes that may warrant consideration. No action will be taken by the Division at the meeting.

The Division will hold the public workshop on **Thursday, September 24, 2026 at 2:00 p.m.** This meeting will be held in person, via Microsoft Teams, and by telephone.
