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Use of New Form C-4A – Release of Medical and Other Information

When an injured employee **electronically** signs a C-4 Form, Claim for Compensation/Report of Initial Treatment, the health care provider must also require Form C-4A be completed by the injured employee with the injured employee's original (wet) signature. An electronic signature is not acceptable on Form C-4A. Both the C-4 Form and C-4A Form must be sent to the employer's workers' compensation insurer/third-party administrator, employer and a copy provided to the injured employee.

Form C-4A is not required when the injured employee provides an original or "wet" signature on the C-4 Form. Questions regarding Form C-4A may be submitted to medunit@dir.nv.gov
