NEVADA LAW GOVERNING CONTRACTORS (NRS & NAC 624)

EXEMPTIONS* - NRS 624.031

Any work to repair or maintain property, the value of which is less than \$1,000, including labor and materials, <u>unless</u>:

- > A building permit is required;
- > Type of work is plumbing, electrical, refrigeration, heating or air-conditioning;
- The work is of a type performed by a licensed contractor in a classification prescribed by the Board that significantly affects the health, safety, and welfare of the general public
- The work is performed as a part of a larger project:
 - (1) The value for which is \$500 or more; or
 - (2) For which contracts of less than \$500 have been awarded to evade the provisions of this chapter
- The work is performed by a person who is licensed by this chapter or by an employee of that person.

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THE VALUE OF A LICENSE

- Must pass trade and law exams
- Must demonstrate financial responsibility
- Must prove years of experience in licensed construction field
- Fingerprints submitted to Board for criminal background checks
- Held responsible to all applicable state laws (construction, building, employment, etc.)



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COMPLIANCE WITH INDUSTRIAL INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS



- NRS 624.256 requires proof of industrial insurance as condition of licensure.
- DIR & DETR are required to notify the NSCB of lapses in industrial insurance or failure to pay contributions to the Unemployment Compensation Fund.

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ADDRESSING VIOLATIONS OF INDUSTRIAL INSURANCE LAWS

Within 3 days of receiving notification from DETR, the NSCB <u>must</u> provide written notice that a contractor's license <u>will</u> be suspended if the workers' compensation violations are not remedied with DETR within 30 days.

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FAILURE TO COMPLY

1st Offense

- Summarily suspend license pursuant to NRS 624.291, until proof of compliance is furnished to the NSCB.
- Require contractor to submit to the NSCB a list of all projects for which
 the contractor has unfulfilled contractual obligations where the contract was
 entered into on or before the date of the notice sent by the Board.
 - Failure to provide a complete list of projects will result in an additional 12 month suspension following receipt of the complete list for a 1st offense, or revocation of the license at a hearing for a 2nd or subsequent offense.

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FAILURE TO COMPLY

1st Offense (continued)

- Contractor shall not submit any bids for new work or begin work on any project not described in the list submitted to the NSCB.
- NSCB must notify the Labor Commissioner and State Public Works
 Board to add contractor's name to list of contractors disqualified from bidding
 or being prequalified to bid public works projects.
 - The names are removed when the respective agencies receive notification from the NSCB that the suspension has been lifted.

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FAILURE TO COMPLY

2nd or Subsequent Offense

- If a contractor fails to maintain its industrial insurance or pay in to the Unemployment Compensation Fund within 5 years after the date of reinstatement from the first offense, the Board shall provide 30 days written notice to the contractor that a hearing will be held for the second offense.
- If the hearing officer determines a second/subsequent violation has been committed within the 5 year period, the license shall be revoked.

LABOR BROKERS & WORKERS' COMPENSATION ISSUES

- OSHA Safety Violations
- Local Building Departments Permit Violations
- Public Utilities Commission Solar Complaints
- Manufactured Housing Division (new) Validated workmanship complaints
- District Attorneys Offices Unlicensed/Criminal Cases

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UNLICENSED? WHAT'S THE BIG DEAL?

- Most likely does not carry workers' compensation insurance homeowner becomes liable for on-the-job injuries.
- Loss of recourse protections; ineligible for Recovery Fund; most likely have to seek restitution through civil litigation.
- No proof the individual is qualified to perform work in the trade or is aware
 of the laws and codes governing the industry.
- NSCB has not been able to verify requirements for licensure, including performing a criminal background check.

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PROTECTIONS WHEN HIRING A LICENSED CONTRACTOR

- Eligibility to file a complaint with the Board up to <u>4 years</u> from the date the work was performed
- Have your concerns investigated by the Board valid workmanship issues may result in a Notice to Correct to your contractor
- Owners of single-family residences may be eligible for the Board's Residential Recovery Fund.



RED FLAGS



- Demands for cash payments only
- Large down payments before work is performed
- Writing checks to an individual instead of a business
- No work or communication for 30+ days
